

ORDINANCE 90-13

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SWIMMING POOL MANAGER AND LIFEGUARDS FOR THE SWIMMING POOL FOR THE CITY OF GALENA AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:


- SECTION 1: That the Manager of the Swimming Pool of the City of Galena, Kansas shall receive the sum of \$1000 per month for a period of 3½ months for a total of \$3500 as salary for the period from one week prior to Memorial Day to one week after Labor Day.
- SECTION 2: As additional compensation, the Manager of the swimming pool of the City of Galena, Kansas shall be entitled and permitted to operate any and all concessions and concession stands within the swimming pool enclosure, providing his own supplies and merchandise and retaining any and all profit therefrom during his term of office.
- SECTION 3: Lifeguards to be paid the minimum wage rate of \$3.80 per hour.
- SECTION 4: This Ordinance repeals any ordinance in conflict herewith.
- SECTION 5: This ordinance will be in full force from and after its approval and publication in the official city newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times.
