

ORDINANCE NO. 90-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-124 OF THE GALENA CITY CODE ESTABLISHING NEW WATER RATES CHARGED FOR EACH CUSTOMER AND USER FOR WATER SERVICE FROM THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM TO THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS FOR CONSUMERS OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: The rates for water service furnished by the waterworks system of the city for consumers outside the city limits shall be as follows:

A. A minimum charge of \$7.50 shall be made for each service unit for which each consumer outside the corporate limits of the city shall be entitled to 1,000 gallons taken during each meter reading month. For amounts in excess of the minimum gallonage set forth above, the charge shall be:

- (1) 1,000 to 4,999 gallons - \$1.58 per 1,000 gallons.
- (2) 5,000 to 9,999 gallons - \$1.46 per 1,000 gallons.
- (3) 10,000 to 14,999 gallons - \$1.30 per 1,000 gallons.
- (4) Over 15,000 gallons - \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 2: Section ~~15-124(a)~~ of the Galena City Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force after its approval and publication in the official city newspaper The Galena Sentinel Times.
