

ORDINANCE 90-8

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE FOLLOWING ALLEY WITHIN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS LOCATED BETWEEN SPARKS AND VINE STREETS, EAST OF JOPLIN STREET TO THE PLOTTED ALLEY JUST WEST OF JEFFERSON STREET: PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, and 14-423.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS IS HEREBY VACATED:

A 250 foot strip of land running East and West and 20 foot running North and South between Lots 63 and 64 located in Empire City Town Company's First Addition to Empire (now Galena) and Lots 75, 76, and 77, 78 located in Empire City Town Company's Fourth Addition to Empire (now Galena).

Vacated land will revert to owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to frontage of such real estate. Land affected by the Ordinance is a 250 foot strip between Lot 63 located in Empire City Town Company's First Addition to Empire (now Galena) and Lots 75 and 76 located in Empire City Town Company's Fourth Addition to Empire (now Galena) on the North and Lot 64 located in Empire City Town Company's First Addition to Empire (now Galena) and Lots 77 and 78 located in Empire City Town Company Fourth Addition to Empire (now Galena) on the South.

The City of Galena, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, can reopen said alley when the Governing Body so deems it necessary, without expense.

The Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities such right of ways and easements, that are necessary and desirable for public service.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of publication in the official City newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of April, 1990.
