ORDINANCE NO. 91-1

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING INSPECTION BY CITY BUILDING INSPECTOR BEFORE GAS SERVICE IS TURNED ON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

SECTION I: No natural gas service shall be provided to any consumer in the City of Galena, Kansas until the City Building Inspector has examined the structure and all lines and hook-ups and determined that the facilities are in compliance with the current city building code.

SECTION II: It shall be the duty of KPL Gas Service Company, or any other provider of gas service, to inform the city of all disconnects within the city, all reconnects within the city, and all new applications for gas service within the city.

SECTION III: It shall be the duty of anyone wishing gas service to inform the city of their intent to acquire service.

SECTION IV: Violation of this ordinance shall subject the violator to a fine of not less than ten nor more than twenty dollars.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the Galena Sentinel Times.
