ORDINANCE NO. 92-10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COURT COSTS, ALLOWING FOR MUNICIPAL JUDGE TRAINING FUND FEES, LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT FUND FEES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING CENTER FUND ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 1991 SUPP 74-5619 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 90-6 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Municipal Court Costs shall be imposed as follows:
Twenty-six Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$26.50) Court Costs plus Fifty Cents (\$.50) Municipal Judge Training Fund Fee, One Dollar (\$1.00) Local Law Enforcement Training Reimbursement Fund Fee and Four Dollars (\$4.00) Law Enforcement Training Center Fund Fee established pursuant of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 74-5619 in addition to any fine imposed.

SECTION 2. That all monies collected as fines, or costs shall be paid to the City Treasurer and credited to the General Operating Fund of the City of Galena. The monies collected for the Municipal Judge Training Fund Fee and the monies collected for the Local Law Enforcement Training Reimbursement Fund Fee and the Law Enforcement Training Center Fund shall be remitted to the State Treasurer monthly.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance repeals Ordinance 90-6 in its entirety and any other ordinance in conflict herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force from and after its approval and publication in the official city newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
