ORDINANCE NO. 93- 12

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE FROM ENTERING THE PREMISES WHEREIN CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE OR ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IS SOLD AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

- Section 1: It shall be unlawful for the owner of premises wherein cereal malt beverage and/or alcoholic liquor is sold and consumed to knowingly allow any person under the age of twenty-one years to enter and remain on the premises unless said person's parent is also physically present on the premises and aware of the person's presence.
- Section 2: In determining whether the owner in Section 1 has knowingly violated this ordinance, the knowledge of agents and employees of the owner shall be attributed to the owner.
- Section 3: It shall be a complete defense to a violation of Section 1 of this ordinance if the owner or his agent or employee, upon learning that a prohibited person is upon the premises, immediately demands that the prohibited person leave and immediately reports the incident to the Galena Police Department.
- Section 4: It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one years to knowingly enter and/or remain on the premises wherein cereal malt beverage and/or alcoholic liquor is sold and consumed unless said person's parent is also physically present on the premises and aware of the person's presence.
- Section 5: Any person attempting to enter or remain upon the premises wherein cereal malt beverage and/or alcoholic liquor is sold and consumed shall carry upon his/her person proof of age as shown by a photo-type identification card and shall present said card to the owner, his agent, or any law enforcement officer upon demand. Any person failing to present said identification upon demand shall be ordered to leave the premises at once. Failure to leave shall be a violation of this ordinance.
- Section 6: This ordinance shall not apply to premises wherein more than fifty percent (50%) of the gross annual receipts are from the sale of tangible products other than intoxicating liquors and cereal malt beverages.
- Section 7: An owner convicted of violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon first conviction, be fined not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and sentenced to not more than ten (10) days in jail, or both, and upon a second conviction within a twelve-month period, be fined not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and sentenced to not more than ten (10) days in jail, or both, and all licenses issued to him for the premises by the City of Galena, Kansas shall immediately become void and of no effect.
- Section 8: Any person convicted of violating Sections 4 or 5 of this ordinance shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and sentenced to not more than ten (10) days in jail for each offense.

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ORDINANCE NO. 93-13

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SEWER FEES WHEN SEWER SERVICE BECOMES AVAILABLE TO CITY RESIDENTS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT:

Section 1: When city sewer service becomes available to any structure within the city which had formerly used a private sewage disposal system, the owner of said structure must stop using the private sewage disposal system and begin using the city system.


Section 2: As soon as city sewer service becomes available, the normal and usual charge for city sewer service shall be added to the water bill or bills that apply to the structure and shall be collected whether the city sewer service is being used or is not being used.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect after publication in the official city newspaper.

Passed by the governing body of Galena, Kansas and approved by the Mayor this 19 day of October, 1993.
