ORDINANCE NO. 93-7

AN ORDINANCE SETTING MAXIMUM TRAFFIC SPEED ON KANSAS HIGHWAY NO. 66, THE SAME BEING SEVENTH STREET WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF GALENA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

Section 1: The maximum speed for vehicular traffic on Kansas Highway No. 66 (K-66), the same being Seventh Street of the City of Galena, for both lanes of traffic, shall be:

- (a) Forty (40) miles per hour from the west city limit of Galena to Dewey Street;
- (b) Thirty (30) miles per hour from Dewey Street east to Bellevue Street;
- (c) Forty (40) miles per hour from Bellevue Street east to a point ninety-one meters (300 feet) west of the Burlington Northern railroad tracks; and
- (d) Fifty-five (55) miles per hour from a point ninety-one meters (300 feet) West of the Burlington Northern railroad tracks to the Missouri State line.


Section 2: Any and all ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
