ORDINANCE NO. 94-1

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING A SURCHARGE OF \$2.50 PER MONTH FOR 120 MONTHS TO GALENA WATER BILLS TO PAY FOR REVENUE BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:

Section 1: Effective with the first billing after publication of this ordinance, each water bill shall be increased by a surcharge of \$2.50 each month for 120 consecutive months.

Section 2: In the case where multiple households are serviced by the same meter, such as apartment houses and housing projects, the billing shall be increased by \$2.50 for each household on the same meter.

Section 3: In the case of trailer parks, the billing shall be surcharged \$2.50 each month for each trailer space occupied on January 1 of each year. For example, if there are six occupied spaces on January 1, 1994, the billing for each month during 1994 shall be the regular billing plus a total surcharge of \$15.00.

Section 4: The proceeds from the surcharge shall be used solely to pay principal and interest on revenue bonds issued in 1994 to improve the water system.

Section 5: The surcharge shall end after 120 months or at such time that the bonds have been fully paid off.


Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force after publication in the official city newspaper.
