

ORDINANCE NO. 94- 17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RESTRICTIONS ON THE FILLING OF VACANT COUNCIL POSITIONS AND PROVIDING THAT A HUSBAND AND WIFE CANNOT BOTH SERVE ON THE COUNCIL AT THE SAME TIME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: In the event the City Council appoints someone to a vacant position on the City Council, the person appointed shall not be a member of the immediate family of any other council person or the mayor or any person holding a supervisory position with the City of Galena.

SECTION 2: A person's immediate family is defined as that person's spouse, mother, father, daughter, son, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother, sister, brother-in-law, and sister-in-law.

SECTION 3: Supervisory positions are defined as City Clerk, City Judge, Police Chief, City Attorney, City Superintendent, Building Inspector, Park Caretaker, Cemetery Sexton, and any police officer above the rank of patrolman.

SECTION 4: The foregoing definitions apply only to the ordinance and for no other purposes.

SECTION 5: In the event two persons already serving on the City Council should marry, one of the two persons must resign effective with the beginning of the next regular meeting of the City Council. In the event neither of the two persons resigns voluntarily, then both of said persons shall be deemed to have resigned effective with the beginning of the next regular meeting of the City Council.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
