

ORDINANCE 94-22

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PULLING METERS THAT HAVE BEEN TAMPERED WITH AND PROVIDING CHARGES THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:


SECTION 1: The city may pull the water meter from any residence when, in the judgment of the city, the water meter has been tampered with for the purpose of obtaining water without authorization from the city.

SECTION 2: If the city pulls a meter as set forth above, the meter shall not be replaced until a \$75.00 reconnect fee is paid to the city, the old deposit for water service is forfeited to the city, and a new deposit for water service in the amount of \$75.00 is paid to the city.


SECTION 3: If a meter is pulled at the request of the property owner, the charges in Section 2 shall not apply. In this instance, the reconnect fee will be \$20.00 and the old deposit will not be forfeited.

SECTION §: This ordinance shall take effect upon being published in the official city newspaper.



Section 9: This ordinance shall take effect upon being published in the official city newspaper.


Section 10: To the extent it is in conflict herewith, Ordinance No. 87-12 is hereby repealed.
