

ORDINANCE 94-8

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM FINES FOR THE FINE SCHEDULE FOR TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND SETTING ASIDE \$5.00 OF THE FINE FOR USE AS A POLICE TRAINING FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction shall be not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 and the municipal judge is authorized to prepare a fine schedule setting forth the standard fine for each infraction within these limits.

SECTION 2: Violators shall be allowed to post bond for their appearance in the amount of the fine set forth in the schedule plus court costs.


SECTION 3: The first \$5.00 of each fine collected shall be placed in a special police training fund to be used for training and education for the police department, including the purchase of necessary educational supplies and equipment.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
