

ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT A CRIME TO KNOWINGLY GIVE OR PASS A WORTHLESS CHECK FOR ANY AMOUNT UNDER \$500.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly pass or give a worthless check, draft, or order within the city of Galena in the amount of less than \$500.00.

Section 2: Giving or passing a worthless check is the making, drawing, issuing or delivering, or causing or directing the making, drawing, issuing or delivering of any check, order or draft on any bank or depository for the payment of money or its equivalent with the intent to defraud and knowing, at the time of the making, drawing, issuing or delivering of such check, order or draft, as aforesaid, that the maker or drawer has not sufficient funds in, or credits with, such bank or depository for the payment of such check, order or draft in full upon its presentation.

Section 3: Upon conviction of a violation of this ordinance, a person shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00 and shall be ordered to make full restitution, including bank charges and court costs. Upon conviction, a person may be sentenced to not more than ten (10) days incarceration.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after being published in the official city newspaper.
