ORDINANCE 95-11

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF TRUCKS KNOWN AS TRACTOR-TRAILER RIGS OR EIGHTEEN WHEELERS IN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS AND SETTING FORTH WHAT ROUTES SUCH VEHICLES MAY USE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: This ordinance applies only to those trucks known as tractor-trailer rigs or eighteen wheelers.

SECTION 2: There is hereby designated the following as a truck route for the use of the above described vehicles. Such route shall be described as follows: Seventh (7th) Street from the West City Limits to the Missouri-Kansas State Line being the East City Limits and Main Street from Main and Clark South to the City Limits on South Main Street.

SECTION 3: It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any of the above described vehicles to be operated on any street in the city of Galena, Kansas except those designated in Section 2 above or except when said vehicles are making a pick-up or delivery of freight or merchandise and are on the most direct route between the designated truck route and the place of pick-up or delivery.


SECTION 4: Upon conviction of any violation of this ordinance, the violator shall be subject to a fine set by the Municipal Court of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$100.00 plus court costs and such other additional fees as shall be set from time to time by the Court or the Governing Body.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in effect upon publication in official city newspaper.
