

ORDINANCE NO. 95-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HIRING OF TWO EMPLOYEES AS STREET CREW AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:

Section 1: There is hereby created two permanent, full time positions to be designated as street crew and to be filled upon recommendation by the Mayor and approved by the City Council.

Section 2: The persons filling the positions shall be paid operator wages and benefits as the same are now and hereafter set by the City Council.

Section 3: The street crew shall be under the direction of the City Superintendent and shall only be assigned to projects involving the city streets, including but not limited to building, repairing, cleaning and maintaining the streets, gutters, curbs, and rights-of-way. In an extreme emergency, the City Superintendent may assign these employees temporarily to other city work but the City Superintendent shall report this to the City Council at its next regular meeting.

Section 4: Anyone appointed to these positions shall lose whatever seniority rights or longevity rights said person has with the City to the fullest extent allowed by law.

Section 5: The street crew, or the City Superintendent on their behalf, shall make a monthly report to the City Council on the activities and progress of the street crew.

Section 6: All costs for these two positions shall come from funds generated by the host fee paid the City by American Disposal Services, Inc., and the positions shall cease upon the cessation of said host fee.

Section 7: This ordinance shall take effect upon being published in the official city newspaper.
