

ORDINANCE 95-6

AN ORDINANCE VACATING OAK STREET BETWEEN THE FOLLOWING LOTS IN EAST SUBDIVISION TO EMPIRE CITY, NOW THE CITY OF GALENA, LOTS 114 AND 115, 138 AND 139, 87 AND 94, 86 AND 95 PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, AND 14-423.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS IS HEREBY VACATED:

Oak Street between lots 114 and 115, 138 and 139, 87 and 94, 86 and 95 all in East Subdivision to Empire City, now City of Galena

The Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities in the vacated land such rights-of-ways and easements that are necessary and desirable for public utility service.


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of publication in the official city newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.


