


ORDINANCE NO. 96-10

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING WATER RATES TO ALL CUSTOMERS BY \$3.50 PER MONTH, BEGINNING WITH THE FIRST BILLING ON OR AFTER DECEMBER 1, 1996, AND PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE FUNDS GENERATED FROM THEREFROM AND FOR THE TERMINATION OF THE CHARGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:


- Section 1: beginning with the first billing on or after December 1, 1996 to the water customers of the City, a surcharge of \$3.50 per month per bill shall be added to the other charges.
- Section 2: The funds generated by the surcharge shall be used by the City for repayment of a loan to the City from Rural Development of the United States Department of Agriculture, said loan to be used to fund the water project.
- Section 3: The surcharge shall cease upon full repayment of the loan.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon being published in the Official City Newspaper.
