SECTION 2: That the above set longevity increase shall be added for each year of service up to a maximum of five (5) years, beginning with thier first pay period following their anniversary date, and excludes any employee hired after January 1, 1987.

SECTION 3: Upon a change in the Federal Minimum Wage rate, all seasonal employees will be paid at the Federal Minimum Wage Rate.

SECTION 4: The first compensation provided for in this ordinance shall become effective March 1, 1997.

SECTION 5: Probational employees will be paid at a rate of \$.25 per hour less than ordinance rate until they have worked 90 days. Part-time salaried employees will be hired on a 90 day probationary period like other employees but will be paid regular Ordinance pay, not probationary pay.

SECTION 6: Ordinance 95-20 is is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times and commencing with the pay period ending MARCH 1, 1997.
