**ORDINANCE NUMBER 99-7**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
GALENA, KANSAS:**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC VISITING HOURS AT ALL  
GALENA, KANSAS CEMETERIES; PENALTY FOR VIOLATION**

**Section 1:** There are three cemeteries located within the corporate city limits of Galena, Kansas to wit: Oak Hill Cemetery, Galena Cemetery and Hillcrest Cemetery. These cemeteries shall be open to the public for any and all purposes not prohibited by law nor interfering with the public peace.

**Section 2:** The hours during which the above named cemeteries shall be open to the public as described in Section 1 above shall be; commencing on April 6 through October 26 of each year the public hours shall be from seven o'clock a.m. until nine o'clock p.m.; commencing October 27 through April 5 of each year the public hours shall be from seven o'clock a.m. until seven o'clock p.m. All person, but those authorized by virtue of their public office or employment, shall be prohibited from entering into or remaining upon the grounds of said cemeteries during hours that the cemeteries are closed to the public.


**Section 3:** Violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute criminal trespass as defined by the current Uniform Public Offense Code for the city of Galena, Kansas; a Class B violation. Upon a conviction of a violation of this ordinance, a person may be sentenced to no more than six months in custody of the chief of police nor fined a sum not to exceed \$1000.00.

**Section 4:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

Passed and Adopted by not less than a two-thirds vote of the Governing Body of the City of Galena, Kansas on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1999.
