

ORDINANCE NUMBER 02-03

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STORAGE FEE FOR THE CITY OF
GALENA, KANSAS IMPOUND LOT**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
GALENA, KANSAS**

Section 1: Ordinance Number 00-10 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: Whenever the City of Galena, Kansas Police Department shall come into possession of a motor vehicle or other similar property and shall cause the same to be removed to the City Impoundment Lot, a storage fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day shall be charged the owner thereof for every day that the vehicle remains in the impoundment lot.

Section 3: Prior to the imposition of said storage fee, the Galena, Kansas Police Department shall mail to or serve upon the registered owner thereof a notice stating that if the owner does not claim such motor vehicle within five (5) days of said notice, the City will impose the storage fee as set forth above. No vehicle shall be released from the impoundment lot until the storage fee has been paid, provided that the Chief of Police or his designee may waive or adjust the storage fees.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 02-03A

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 02-03 FOR THE CITY OF
GALENA, KANSAS IMPOUND LOT**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
GALENA, KANSAS**

Section 1: Ordinance Number 02-03 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2: Whenever the City of Galena, Kansas Police Department shall come into possession of a motor vehicle or other similar property and shall cause the same to be removed to the City Impoundment Lot, a storage fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day shall be charged the owner thereof for every day that the vehicle remains in the impoundment lot.

Section 3: No vehicle shall be released from the Impoundment Lot until the storage fee has been paid, provided that the Chief of Police or his designee may waive or adjust the storage fees.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.
