ORDINANCE NO. 08-01

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE PENALTIES FOR PERMITTING A DOG OR CAT TO RUN AT LARGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS that:

Section 1. Chapter 2, Article 2, of the Code of the City of Galena is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-206 RUNNING AT LARGE; FINE. (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner or harbinger of any dog or cat to permit such dog to run at large within the city at any time;


(b) Any dog or cat running at large within the city shall be impounded as set out in section 2-207;

(c) The owner or harbinger of any dog or cat that shall run at large shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$200.00 for such offense.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
