ORDINANCE NO. 10-2

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ELM STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:


Section 1. A portion of the platted street know as Elm Street west of the intersection of Elm Street and Jefferson Street, according to the recorded plat thereof, that is legally described as "Beginning at the SW Corner of Lot 77 in Empire City Town Company's 4th Addition to the City of Empire (now Galena), thence South 25 feet, thence East 75 feet, thence North 25 feet to a point on the South boundary line of Lot 78 thence West 75 feet to the point of beginning," is hereby vacated and such vacation is hereby deemed necessary or expedient. This action is taken pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, and any amendments thereto.

Section 2. The City reserves for the City the rights for public utilities, rights-of-ways, and easements for public service facilities in existence and use.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication in the official city newspaper unless a written protest is filed in the office of the city clerk before the expiration of such time.


