ORDINANCE NO. 10-6

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REFUSE
COLLECTION FEES; EFFECTIVE DATE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
GALENA, KANSAS that:

Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 15 of the Code of the City of Galena is hereby amended to add a section to read as follows:

15-306 COLLECTION FEES. Fees for collection of refuse and garbage are as follows:

(a) Each residential unit within the city, using water and/or sewer service, shall be charged at the rate of \$8.36 per month for one person or \$11.66 per month if more than one person resides at the address.

(b) All residential units outside the city limits using water and/or sewer service, and those otherwise using the refuse and garbage collection services of the city, shall be charged at the rate of \$12.65 per month for one person or \$15.95 per month if more than one person resides at the address.

(c) The minimum charge for commercial and industrial business, listed as a water customer, shall be \$20.90 per month. If a dumpster is required by a commercial or industrial business rather than the minimum charge of \$20.90 being assessed the charge shall be as stated in section (d) as below.

(d) Dumpster charges shall be as follows, stated as per month charges:

<u>Size</u>	<u>Minimum</u>	<u>2 Pickups</u>	<u>3 Pickups</u>
1 ½ yard	\$39.38	\$52.58	\$71.06
2 yard	\$53.90	\$67.10	\$86.90
3 yard	\$63.14	\$76.34	\$96.14
4 yard	\$71.06	\$84.26	\$104.06
6 yard	\$80.30	\$93.50	\$113.30

(e) Refuse and garbage collection fees not paid shall become a lien upon the real estate to which the services were furnished.

(f) The City of Galena shall have sole discretion for purposes hereunder to determine whether service at a particular location shall be classified as residential, commercial, or business. If a premises is used for both residential and commercial or business purposes it shall be classified as commercial or business for purposes of assessing the above rates.

The rates specified herein shall be in effect commencing June 1, 2010.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official City newspaper.

Section 3. The provisions of any ordinance that are in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Passed and approved by the City Council of Galena, Kansas, this 26th day of April, 2010, by a vote of at least 4 councilmembers.
