ORDINANCE NO. 10-11

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ALTERNATE DATE FOR REGULAR
CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS THAT FALL ON A HOLIDAY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GALENA,
KANSAS:**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Galena, Kansas, upon due consideration of the matter, finds that enacting the legislation below would promote a more effective method for conducting city affairs; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of Galena, Kansas, finds it should adopt the following regulation in order to provide a certain substitute date for regular city council meetings that would have fallen on a holiday.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS that:

Section 1. Section 1-207 of the City of Galena is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-207 REGULAR MEETINGS OF COUNCIL. The regular meeting of the city council shall be held on the first and third Mondays of each calendar month at 6:00 p.m. in the city council room at the city hall, for the purpose of taking under advisement and acting upon such business as may come before the governing body.


In the event a regular city council meeting scheduled to occur on the first or third Monday of a calendar month should fall on a holiday recognized by the city, such meeting shall not occur. Instead, the meeting shall be held at 6:00 p.m. on the next day that is not a holiday or weekend day. Any meeting cancelled due to inclement weather or other hazards shall be held on the next day at 6:00 p.m. that is not a holiday, weekend day, or date in which inclement weather or hazards prevent it from occurring.

Section 2. Ordinance 09-03 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon one publication in the official city newspaper.


