Re: Request to store scrap metal in the Cell B4 area at the City of Galena construction and demolition landfill, Permit 738, Galena, CK Co.

Dear Ms. Charles:

I am writing to respond to Mr. Greg Klumper's e-mail request to store scrap metal in a permitted disposal area not fully developed for disposal. Soils in Cell B4 have been excavated for use as cover, but the area has not had construction quality assurance performed that would allow disposal in the area. The rationale for the request is the current slump in scrap metal prices.

Currently the operating plan's Section F, DESCRIPTION OF ALL SALVAGING OPERATIONS states, "Recycled scrap metal is to be directed to an independent scrap metal container which is to be located adjacent to the active area but remote from the C&D waste disposal or screening area. The collected cardboard and scrap metal is to be removed from the site on an as-needed basis and shipped for recycling." Therefore, because the request does not propose container storage, it presents a minor permit modification.

The request is conditionally approved. The approval condition is: The metal salvaging will be performed in accordance with Kansas Administrative Regulation 28-29-308(1)(2 & 3), i.e., "the salvage operation and salvaged materials shall be controlled to prevent interference with the prompt disposal of C&D wastes," and "all salvage operations shall be conducted in a manner that does not create a nuisance."

This approval is considered a minor operating plan modification pursuant to General Condition 4(b) in Permit 738. Please amend the operating plan for this facility consistent with your request and this approval. One way to accomplish this would be to insert copies of this approval letter into the approved operations plan. By copy of this letter, the amendment is being forwarded to KDHE's District Office for their file as well.

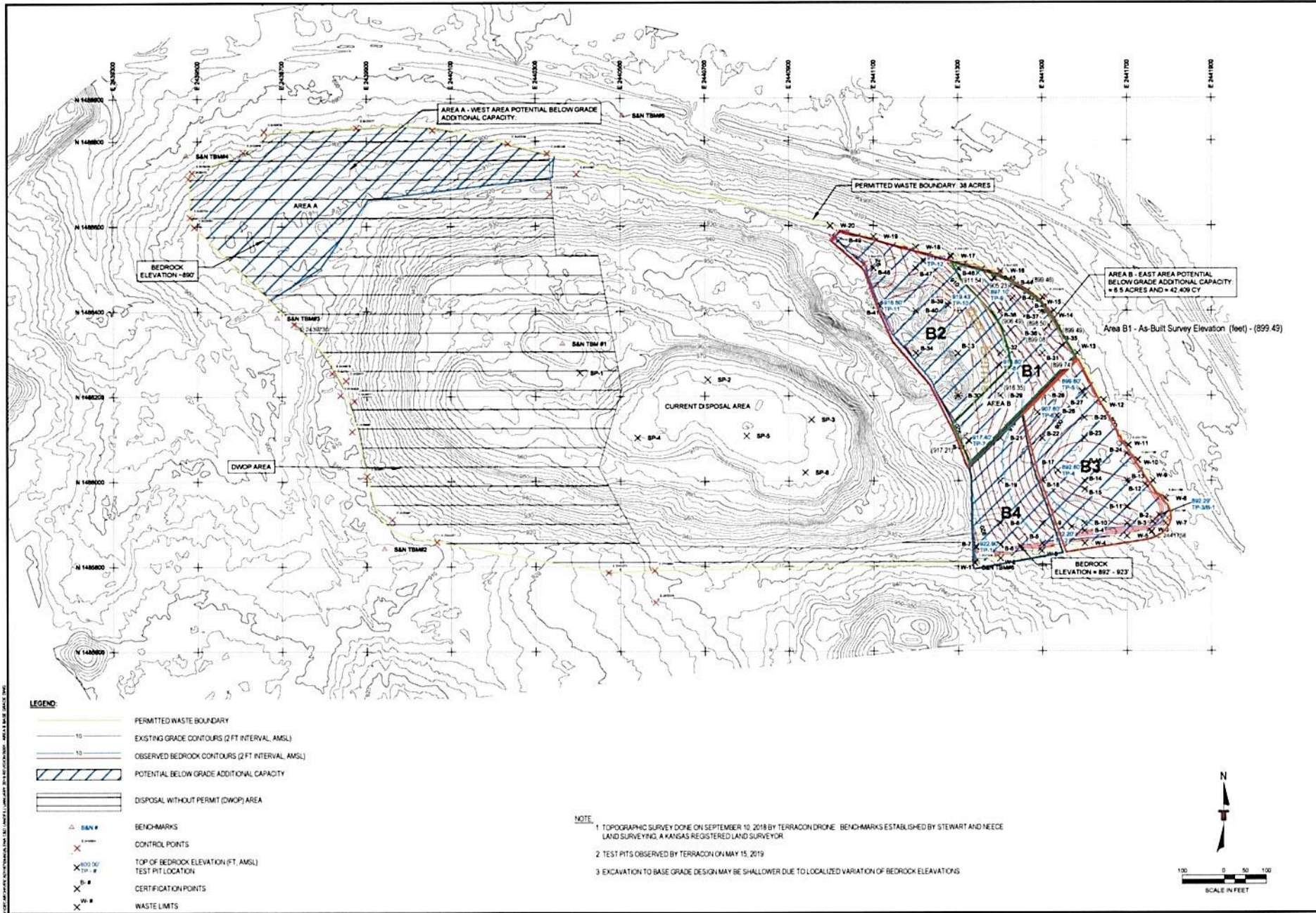
